**SUBJECT:** Influence of International Business

**SPEAKER:** Malcolm Benfer



- Spoke about his experiences with Australian Aerospace Limited;
- Illustrated the need for tolerance and understanding in working for a company that has distinct cultures, French, German, Spanish and Australian.;
- He emphasized that tolerance can make a difference, even in a country like Afghanistan;
- He indicated that there was a difficulty with language but this was overcome, particularly in Europe where English is the common business language;
- He had found it a little disconcerting in fronting the cultures in France but also those specific to regions within the country;
- Food is a very important part of cross culture interface;
- The issues of permanent employment for life that exist in France and Spain are an anathema to Australians, requiring significant understanding;
- In dealings on the international front you must have a level of humility;
- The French have worked well in assimilating into the Australian work culture;
