**SUBJECT: INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION**  
**SPEAKER: PAULA DUNSTAN**

- Identified the issues associated with the professionalization of international education
- International education In Australia had its "roots" in the 1950's with the Colombo Plan
- The Colombo Plan occupies a prominent place in the history of Australia's relations with Asia., where it is best remembered for sponsoring thousands of Asian students to study or train in Australian tertiary institutions.
- International education currently involves half a million overseas students
- Provides for the benefit of cultural exchange
- Relates to people, relationships and services
- Chinese students have increased from 3,600 in 1997 to 96,553 in 2009
- 75.5% of Indian students are male
- There are more Japanese female students than male
- Commented that the recent media outrage by Indian students is not unusual when considered in the context of historical protests by other ethnic groups.
- The use of Education Agents creates some complex issues because they do not form part of the institutional staffing
- International Business is everyone's business
