Youth Service Director : Colin Melvin: No Report

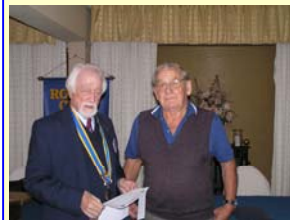
