**TOPIC:** Cuba, South America & the Galapagos Islands Adventure

- The total trip six weeks in duration, including Galapagos Islands, Ecuador, Bolivia, Chile, Argentina and Cuba.
- Galapagos islands situated on the equator, 1000km west of Ecuador. Requires 7-10 days to do the islands justice
- Volcanic islands noted for the bird and animal life
- The Charles Darwin Research Centre is located on the islands.
- Lack of natural drinking water has significantly curtailed its growth.
- Ecuador located on the equator. Had the opportunity to stand right on the equator
- Bolivia proved extremely interesting with ladies clothing being of note
- Country has a huge salt lake that produces 25,000 tonnes of salt per annum
- Chile and Argentina all provided unique experiences
- Spent 2 weeks in Cuba
- Interesting country of 11 million inhabitants.
- Predominantly rural (subsistent farming)
- Everyone appears to have a job but what the job is not clear
- The food was fairly "ordinary" buildings were solid but in need of significant maintenance
- Would I go to Cuba again—NO
